Cardinal Named to Advance Cause of 'Lily of Mohawks'

Beatification process of Catherine Tekakwitha Attracts Wide Interest at Vatican as Historical Committee Meets To Study Girl's Life

Vatican City—His Eminence Carlo Cardinal Salotti has been appointed pontifical Relator of the cause for the beatification of Catherine Tekakwitha, "Lily of the Mohawks."

Of this amount it has been estimated that \$2,000,000 will be required for administrative expenses. This contemplates the employment of 6,816 persons on full-time, of whom 2,734 will be attached to the Board offices in Washington and 4,082 in the field.

The allotments for this fund will be follows:

For old-age assistance \$50,000,000. For unemployment compensation administration \$20,000,000. For aid to dependent children \$35,000,000.

For aid to the blind \$8,000,000.

Out of the fund \$15,000,000 will be allotted for computing wage rates and assigning account numbers to all employees subject to the old-age benefit provisions of the Act.

The Board estimates that there were in 1934 236,000 persons receiving old-age assistance in 25 States and 2 territories. It is further estimated that of the individuals now on relief rolls, 665,000 will be qualified for old-age assistance under State plans approved by the Board.

In States which have enacted or are expected to enact unemployment insurance laws conforming to Federal standards, it is anticipated that \$10,000,000 will be collected in the form of payroll taxes. Ten percent of this will be required for administrative purposes. Only the latter item, \$20,000,000, appears in the proposed appropriation.

At the end of 1934 approximately 110,000 families in 43 States were receiving mothers' and about 335,000 mothers' and families were on relief. It is estimated therefore, that 442,000 families will be entitled to aid for dependent children. The total amount will be \$17,300,000 but of this amount the Federal government will pay only \$3,000,000.

It is estimated that there are 100,000 blind individuals in the country. Probably \$1,000 will be entitled to assistance in addition to \$2,000 received under 24 State laws in 1934.

The Board estimates that 26,000,000 wage earners will be registered.



Pontiff one who submits and reports on a case for Roman congregation, in this case, a cardinal appointed to take charge of a cause for beatification, known as the "Cardinal Relator."
