Relics Of Apostles Discovered In Attic

Dutch Priest Finds Relics of Philip, Thomas, Bartholomew and Other Saints in Rectory of Old Dating Back 700 Years; Search Continued

The Hague. At least 1000 relics including those of the Apostles Philip, Thomas and Bartholomew and of St. Eugene who suffered martyrdom under Diocletian and St. Philo, disciple of St. Benedict have been discovered in the attic of the old rectory of the church of St. Peter's Chair at Antwerp in the town of Sittard.

The church dates from the year 1200 and it is thought that before that time there was another church on the site.

Father B. H. Henkens who is investigating the history of the church recently was transferred from Antwerp to pastor at Sint-Eustachius in the ocean of the transfer expressed his determination to learn what will become of at least some of the large number of relics found when the church of St. Peter's Chair was at one time famous throughout Western Europe.

Upon taking possession of the old rectory Father Henkens immediately began the search.
