The annual graduation exercises of six Elmira schools were held at the Elmira High School on Sunday. A total of 177 pupils graduated.

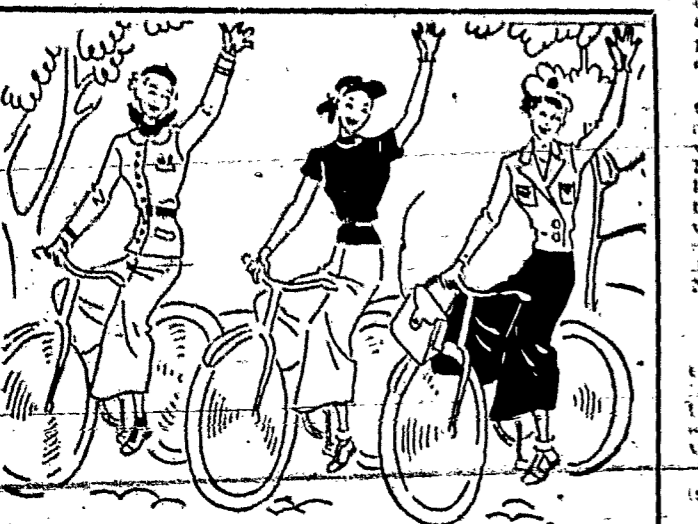
