

Monsignor Shay Speaks At Retreat Conference

Delegation Enthusiastic
Over Chicago Conference



Rev. Dr. Rev. Msgr. Charles F. Shay, moderator William G. O'Farrell, president, and Walter T. Sculley, secretary of the Laymen's Better League, have returned from the Sixth National Laymen's Retreat Conference held June 21-25 over the weekend ended Saturday. Over the retreat, more than 1,000 laymen participated throughout the country.

Monsignor Shay presided at the conference which was held Saturday afternoon in the absence of the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Joseph M. Corrigan, rector of the Catholic University of America.

"Much To Be Done"

While the retreat work was carried out here it has been excellently done," Msgr. Shay told the CATHOLIC COURIER today. "The task which is much to be done in attaining the real objective of the movement—closed retreats in small group of men in the same walls of 150."

The reports of such retreats held even in the mission territory of Arkansas and other western states were most inspiring. Bishops of these dioceses declared that from "Duke of the Bishop" Mike Reardon, Bishop of Joliet, Ill., to the Catholic Action groups in the West, Catholic Action has developed ways of working by qualified laymen and means of making its speakers more results from those of the past retreats.

The conference in Chicago also showed considerable cooperation between the patronage of H. C. Dunn, layman, by his less person to the venerable representative of Jesus Christ, Father H. F. P. Poppe.
