WASHINGTON (NC)—The "whispering" campaign which always seems to put in an appearance on the eve of a national election has got off to an early start. It is being carried on by candidates who have no more convincing basis than that "somebody said" or "a friend was told by a friend," are beginning to circulate.

BISHOPS FACE GRAVE CRISIS IN GERMANY

Facts Disclose Religious Trials As Fiasco; Arrest Figures Padded

(Continued from Page 1) their fellow religious, while others were accused of alleged political transgressions and are in no way linked up with "immoral practices." There are only five or seven who actually appear to be guilty of deplorable infractions against their monastic duties, indeed, a small number who in the intense effort of the Nazi police to discredit the Church as a whole is considered.

In addition, to understand fully the scandalous proceedings, it is important to know that the charges against the defendants were brought almost exclusively from among the feeble minded patients of the Nazi prisons. The Nazi press has not refrained in spite of these circumstances from bearing all religious Orders as a unit on a most unjust and deplorable charge.

Plain People Wonder. "Have we Catholics become a lawless people?" he asked. "Have we lost our rights? And he went on referring both to the religious and to the lay members of the Church.
