### NEW TESTAMENT REVISION PROBLEMS TO BE STUDIED BY CONFRATERNITY

NEW YORK (NC) — A special section of the Confraternity of the Christian Doctrine, Catholicical Congress, to be held here October 3 to 6, will be devoted to a study of the problems connected with the revision of the common edition of the New Testament in English.

The work of the revision has been undertaken by a group of priests trained in the biblical sciences and otherwise qualified to produce a sound and readable edition of the New Testament in English. The committee is to publish with the text a one-volume commentary on the Book of the New Testament.

The present English New Testament was first published by a group of scholars at the English College at Rheims in 1852. This edition was later revised by Bishop Challoner, whose work appeared from 1749 to 1762.

This revision amounted almost to a new translation and a substantial improvement in the text. The latest editions such as that of Haydock in 1811, achieved chiefly by the Confraternity. This edition was generally approved for the Catholic of the United States by the Second Council of Baltimore, but even then the advisability of a new revision was recognized. The present undertaking is in line with this advice.

The continued progress in biblical studies and the further alterations in the English language make this new revision a necessity. It is stated, it will be, the its production a translation from the Vulgate, the official text of the Church. It is intended to eliminate the difficulties and obscurities which result from an idiom which is obsolete and from language forms no longer in use. The hope is entertained that it will also give new life to the popular reading and study of the New Testament.

Although the immediate object of the undertaking may be considered popular, the work, it is emphasized, is being brought forward with all scholarly care. The importance of the project is recognized by all interested in it, and authorities at Rome have given their highest commendation.
