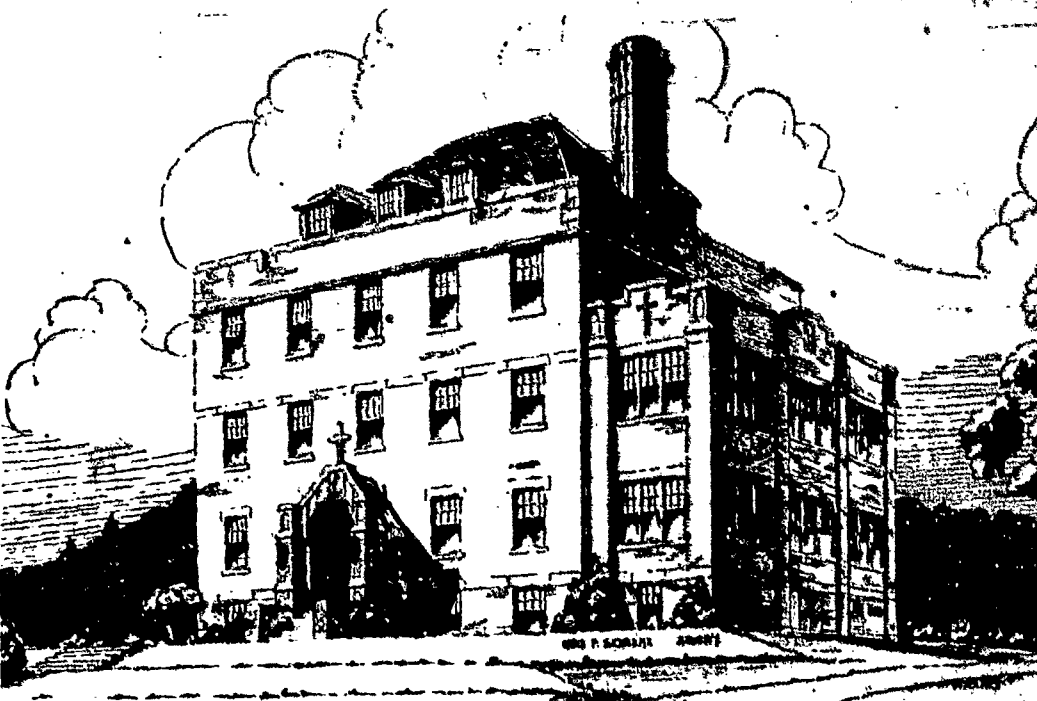

ADMITS RIGHT OF FEDERAL SCHOOL AID

Private and Parochial Institutions Can Benefit, New Study Says

NEW YORK—The right of private and parochial schools to benefit from federal aid and support of public education is admitted in a report made under the auspices of the Columbia University Council for Research in the Social Sciences.

The book, which is published by the Bureau of Publications of the Columbia University Teachers College, is described as "a report on an investigation of educational need and relative ability of states to support education as they have on federal aid to education."

In the chapter on "The Status of Federal Support," the report states that "the question of what constitutes public education from the viewpoint of the federal government is a perplexing one."

So far as the federal Constitution is concerned, however, the book states no doubt that the federal government has no right to interfere with state education.
