#### THE THINGS THAT ARE NOT CAESARS. By Jacques Maritain. People who look solely to politics or governmental reform for the cure of social ills act in effect as if they had "no king but Caesar." But Christ is King and has His rights upon which the State may not trespass. Aligned to these divine rights are certain fundamental rights of man which the State must hold as sacred and beyond its encroachment. In these days when the omnipotent totalitarian State is an actural issue in certain European countries and a potential threat in several others, it is urgent that Catholics understand what are the limits of human authority and the scope of both human and divine rights. Maritain's book is a lucid study of the problem. It avoids the emotional jargon and bombast

which so many people bring into the discussion of politics and religion. It is an excellent book for studious spiritual reading during this season of Christ the King. THE OPEN LETTER OF ROBERT LOUIS STEVENSON TO THE REV.

Mr. Hybr. This is one of the classic letters of all literature ; and yet, although a copy has been in the C. E. Library for the last three years, it has been taken out by only two or three people. It was written by the famous author of "Treasure Island" in answer to a Presbyterian minister of Honolulu who had written disparagingly of Father Damiers, the apostle of the lepers of Molokai. For the "retort courteous" and the "reproof valiant," this letter is a miniature masterpiece. As from one Presbyterian to another in impassioned defense of a Catholic priest, it has a human interest in proportion to ils literary power.
