Division Among Spain's Catholics To Blame For Misfortune, Prelate Says

Rome (NC)—The Most Rev. Felix Bilbao, Bishop of Tortosa, who escaped from Spain and is now at Rome, holds the lack of cooperation among Spanish Catholics responsible for much of the present strife in his unfortunate country.

"The greatest misfortune for Spain," he said when interviewed here, "has been precisely this deplorable division among Catholics which made any effective Catholic action impossible and prevented the formation of strongly built Catholic organizations. On the other hand, the Leftist parties, especially the Socialists, were strongly organized and by means of an intense propaganda drew the laboring masses to them. Although composed of the most heterogeneous elements, the Popular Front formed a compact bloc. Within the National Front, to the contrary, great dissension reigned among its members."

For the last 30 years, Bishop Bilbao stated, Spain had little chance to develop politically. Ministers have succeeded Ministers at too short intervals, so that no serious political work has been accomplished. From 1922 to 1931, he added, "we had a dictatorship under Primo de Rivera. Peace reigned for a time in the country, but the Government committed some gross errors which in 1931, made the establishment of the Republic desirable. Asana came into the Government, he had only a small following thanks to the strength of some groups oriented toward the Right. Finally the triumph of the Popular Front came on February 14, 1936."

"Opposing interests. In the first five years of the Republic, different groups were proposed, but as the result of opposing interests and the personal views of certain politicians these social ameliorations, which oriented much in peace brought little change to the situation."

"In the religious domain a great activity developed. It is unjust to hold the clergy responsible for this expression of popular hatred. They have had their faults, but in the domain of charity, great things have been done. In the domain of instruction and education likewise, it can be affirmed that these very Religious who are now being pursued with such blind fury have done good work."

"Furthermore, the Spanish Nation has been profoundly religious perhaps more so than any other European nation. And that would have continued to be true if Spain had had a good direction and strong government. However, the peace that reigned on the religious terrain was only an apparent peace. In the first place, the knowledge of the people on religious matters was not exact. In the second place, a Catholic policy was never carried out and the field was left open to the revolutionary elements. Thus the denouement which we have witnessed slowly but surely developed."

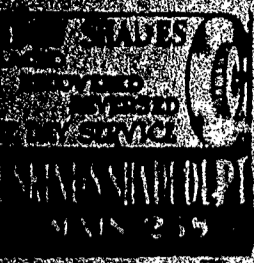

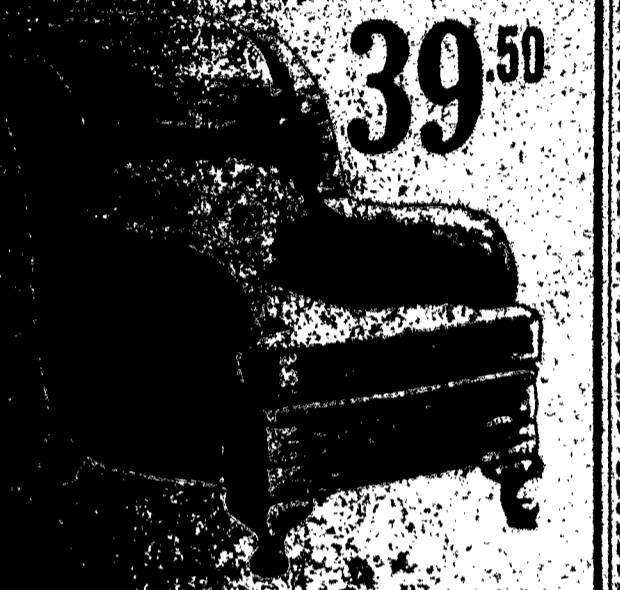
