Papal Secretary Leaves on Liner After National Air Tour

NEW YORK (NC)—His Eminence Eugenio Cardinal Pacelli, Papal Secretary of State, sailed for Italy aboard the liner Conte di Savoia, saying that, despite the great distances he traveled and the many things he saw during his month's visit to the United States, "all has proceeded so pleasantly that I can say that I am not at all fatigued and that I have enjoyed all that I have seen and done."

His Eminence said he visited 12 of the 16 Ecclesiastical Provinces in the United States and conferred with Bishops from 15 of these Provinces, 79 Bishops in all. He visited nearly every type of religious institution, he added.

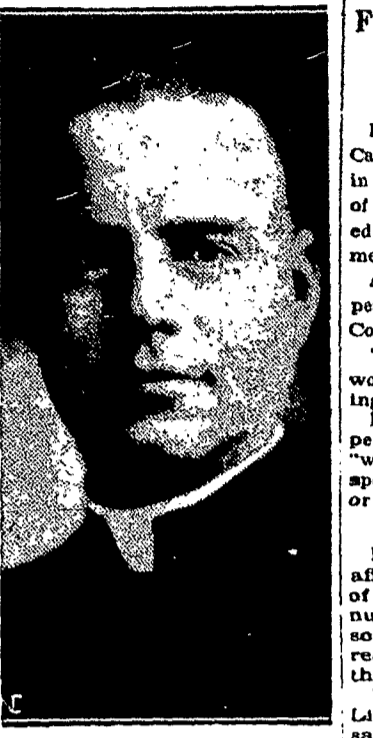
SIXTEEN JESUITS MARTYRED DURING SPANISH REVOLT

ST. JOSEPH MO. The Most Rev. Charles Francis Buddy, Rector of St. Joseph's Cathedral here, who has been named Bishop of the newly-created Diocese of San Diego, is a priest of widespread popularity and is particularly well known for his tireless efforts in behalf of the destitute and the sick.

Bishop-elect Buddy established on January 1, 1936, St. Vincent's Cafeteria and Men's Shelter for the destitute of this city and for transients. This agency provided an average of 3,000 meals a day to the needy and gave lodgings to some 700 men in 1934. St. Vincent's Cafeteria and Men's Shelter was taken over by the Federal Government as a transient shelter.

CARDINAL SEES COMMUNISM AS PERIL OF HOUR

French Prelate Points To Spain and Russia As Examples of Red Rule

PARIS—His Eminence Achille Cardinal Lienart, Bishop of Lille, in addressing the closing session of the Diocesan Congress, denounced Communism as the principal menace of the hour.

After commenting upon the appeals addressed to Catholics by the Communists, His Eminence said: "I should like to believe their words but I am prevented from doing so by their acts." "He then reviewed what is happening in Russia and in Spain. "where its hate is such that it respects neither the life nor the honor of its victims."

Avoid Fear His Eminence urged the avoidance of fear in the face of the danger. "Removing the danger, it leaves the field free. As to force, there are many. His Eminence stated, who are organized to oppose the brutal onslaught and the installation of a regime contrary to the most sacred liberties. "I neither condemn nor approve them for, in this political domain, the Church leaves to citizens an effective liberty," he said. "But who does not see the misfortune of a nation divided into two opposing blocs?"

The Cardinal prescribed that the people of France, with indefatigable patience and by means of documents and definite facts, be enlightened as to the trap into which Communism leads. It is equally important, he added, not to leave the people without hope of attaining a happy and salutary issue.

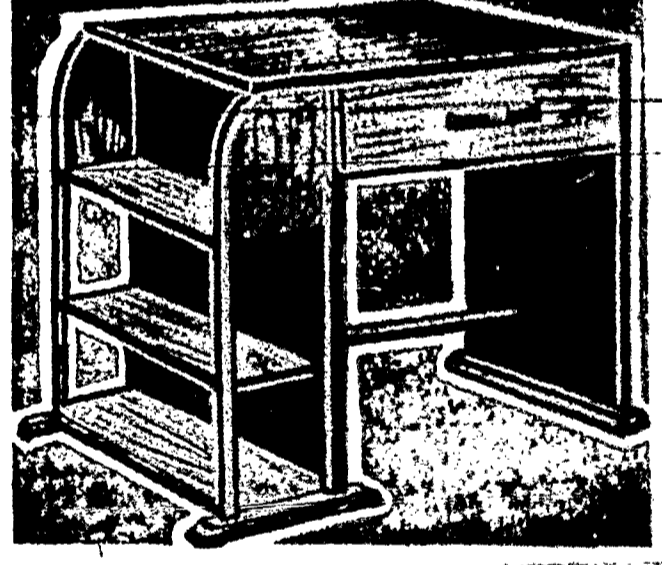
