Utilizing the formal and impressive medium of an Encyclical Letter, His Holiness, Pope Pius XI bestowed high praise on the crusade against immoral motion pictures conducted under the leadership of the American Hierarchy; expressed a wish for continuance; and called upon the Bishops of the entire world to take similar action, exercising "painstaking vigilance over the motion pictures" for the protecting of the morality of their people.

With His Eminence Patrick Cardinal Hayes, Metropolitan of the New York Province presiding at the throne, a distinguished array of the hierarchy paid final tribute to the Most Rev. William Turner, Bishop of Buffalo at St. Joseph's Cathedral.

Specifically denying any intention of entering the realm of politics, and saying that "the Church of Cincinnati expressed no preference for political parties, groups or individuals," the Most Rev. John T. McNicholas, O.P., Archbishop of Cincinnati addressed to his subjects, religious and lay a letter in which he asked prayers that God will guide the voters of the United States in the November elections.

Robles, Calvo Sotelo and Ventosa Calvell who denounced the burning of churches and other vandal acts before the Cortes produced a salutary effect elsewhere notwithstanding the fictitious parliamentary triumph of the Popular Front.

Charges that the Catholic Church in the Philippine Islands is "opposed to democracy" and that the President of the Commonwealth, Manuel Quezon is "presumably still a Mason," as published in the May 30 issue of Collier's Magazine, were refuted in an open letter to Collier's published by the Jesuit Philippine Bureau of New York and written by the Rev. Ferdinand Schoberg, S.J., of Georgetown University.

Although failing to cancel a bathing beauty contest conducted at an El Paso, Texas public park, the vigorous protest of the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women against the event resulted in the withdrawal of many business firms as sponsors of contestants and brought widespread praise from such business firms and other commercial establishments as well as from prominent persons in El Paso.

The Most Rev.
