

## Archbishop To Ordain Priest At Cathedral

Rochester Graduate of  
Niagara Seminary To  
Sing First Mass Here

The Rev. Bernard A. Drew will be ordained to the Holy Priesthood for the Diocese of Rapid City, South Dakota on Saturday morning December 20 at 8:30 a.m. at St. Patrick's Cathedral, by the Most Rev. Edward Mooney, Bishop of Rochester.

The Rev. Ray Meier, S. C., Chaplain to the pastor of St. Bernard's Seminary, the Rev. William F. Bertrand, Chancellor of the Diocese, the Rev. David Hall, F. M. of St. Bonaventure Monastery will assist the Archbishop in the ceremony.

The Rev. Fr. Peter Charles O' Shea will be vicar for Father Drew.

Father Drew will celebrate his first Solemn High Mass at the Church of the Immaculate Conception on Sunday December 20 at eleven o'clock.

The sermon will be preached by Rev. Shay, pastor of St. Patrick's Cathedral.

The Ms. Rev. Msgr. Joseph S. Cameron, pastor of the church of the Immaculate Conception will be an archpriest. Other officers of the first Solemn High Mass will be named at a later date.

Father Drew is the son of Mrs. G. and George E. Drew. He resides with his parents and brothers at 107 Frost Avenue. He completed his preliminary studies at St. John's Seminary in Rochester and has completed his theological course at the Seminary of Our Lady of Angels, Niagara University, New York.

This institution is conducted by the Vincentian Fathers who also have charge of the Rochester University Business School in Rochester.
