EDMONTON, ALTA.—Flight of eight residents in the isolated Catholic mission on the Hornaday river 400 miles east of Aklavik, several hundred miles within the Arctic...

They got back half the food had been eaten by the dogs and man. They could only make the trip by the priests hussening themselves to the sleighs or pushing on the bundles most of the way to help the weakened dogs.

Eleven days later, after an unsuccessful attempt, Berry got away with his six passengers at 10:35 a. m., with only a faint reflection of the sun in the southeast showing. Up until noon it was necessary to use a flashlight to see the instrument board, the Arctic twilight was so dull.

1922 FOKINGTON MANOR, one of the most historic old mansions in the District of Columbia, has been acquired by the Disalced Carmelite Fathers of the Catholic University and, with the approbation of the Most Rev. Michael Curley, Archbishop of Baltimore, will shortly be conducted as a distinctive retreat house for women.

1927 SEVERAL churches in London are planning to install bells in their towers, now that the Catholic Relief Act has removed the legal ban. The first Catholic bell to be christened since the passing of the act was blessed with full ceremonial this week at St. Bridget's, Isleworth, near London.
