on parole and he revisited the United States, being received every-where with marks of esteem. He was accorded by Congress a grant of land and an addition to his pension. He lived some years near Paris

and devoted himself to agricultural pursuits, but subsequently retired to Switzerland after refusing to violate his parole by serving with Napoleon against Russia. A fall from a horse caused his death. His body was taken to Krakow and interred in the Cathedral. Kosciuszko was born near died at Solothurn, Switzerland, in 1817.
