**Dr. McGuire Takes Issue with Library Signpost Author on Article About Spain**

I was amused when opening my CATHOLIC COURIER this morning to see that the Library Signpost had a copy of George Shuster's article in the COMMONWEAL, and had advised his readers to have "patience" to read his six columns of disquisitions on the Spanish situation. He says that he is "personally somewhat of a 'No War' Signpost," but in the very next sentence he says he "agrees" with Mr. Shuster's "significant article" because "a copy will be found on the C. E. Library table."

There is no word of placid alongside of it on the library table some of the numerous articles that have been appearing in the Catholic press for the past twelve months all containing the "praiseworthy" of Mr. Shuster, which might well enable the visitors to the library to correct Mr. Shuster's "ignorant assumptions" nor is there a word about America's protest against the "significant article" which is a word that call the reader's attention to the "very significant" sentence with which Mr. Shuster opens his "very significant article": "I know little about Spain."

forces now in conflict, much less for sympathy with the "royalist" defense. That is, it is not necessary to go to Spain now, depend on the journalists writing from Spain. I will return to this argument at another time. Here I will merely indicate some of the proofs:

1. At New York, C. Bellows, the takes pride in the head of the government of Valencia, sent the passage to Moscow. "The Spanish people will never forget the assistance they received from their Russian brethren. But during the war after the war they will forget the aid of the Russian people, and the great nation." In other words, Spain is now a western Soviet and will continue to be "after the war."

2. The Holy Father speaking from the wetchstones of Christianism and with a knowledge derived from what a Protestant historian has described as "the best informed Chancery in Europe," has told the world and us that the conflict in Spain is one between Christ and anti-Christ. That is enough for me, even if I know nothing else about Spain.

3. The Cardinal Ruffini has said the very same thing repeated before and after the publication of the encyclical, also has told the world the Pope's address to the Spanish refugees. The Spanish bishops, have repeated the Pope's declaration. They know what the Pope means. They are the "Holy Ones" of the Church. That is enough for me, even if I know nothing else about Spain. But there are four Spanish Canons, of a different judgment. I will deal with them later.
