Church Cited**

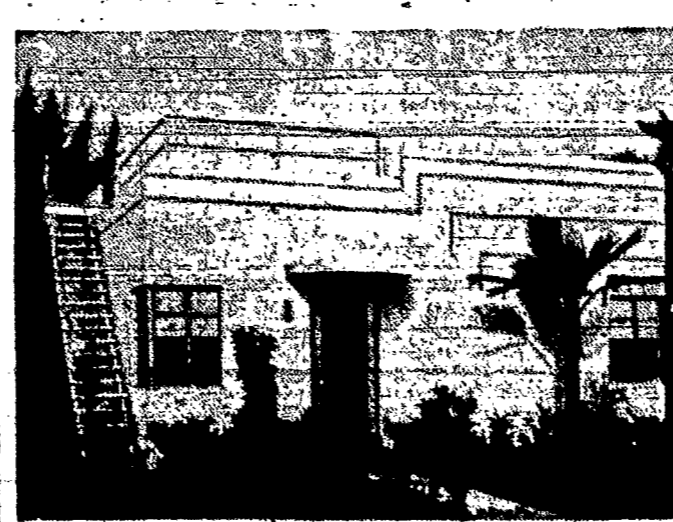
**He's Weak Catholic; Fr.  
Kelley Tells Nocturnal  
Adoration Group**  
Spread a "divine discontent" among all men throughout the city to know, love and serve God better and thus nullify the influence of subversive forces.  
That was the exhortation made to 300 members of Rochester Nocturnal Adoration Society at their annual Communion Breakfast, Sunday morning by the Rev. William J. Kelley, O.M.I., of Buffalo.  
Terming them "Anti-Godists," Father Kelley pointed out that the new enemy threatening the Church was to be resisted and repulsed with the same spirit of courage manifested by the Crusaders who responded to the call of Pope Urban VIII.  
"Our present Holy Father," Father Kelley said, "has unmasked the monster of monsters menacing the Church today, the Communist. In my mind there exists an even greater enemy and that is the Jew, the selfish, compromising Catholic."  
Catholic Action Defined.  
Catholic Action he defined as the participation of the laity with the hierarchy for defense of moral and religious principles.  
"You are in the Nocturnal Adoration Society and started right at the foot of Christ in the tabernacle. To advance in the work of Catholic action means study all over again of the principles of our Catholic faith done under a moderator appointed by the Bishop."  
Fortified with a knowledge of Christ's principles and imbued with a love of Him, as they have shown by their devotion to their society, the noted Orator urged his hearers to go forth and spread these principles throughout the community.  
Archbishop Says Mass.  
Members of the Society received Holy Communion at the 7:30 o'clock mass at St. Patrick's Cathedral, which was celebrated by the Most Rev. Archbishop Edward Mooney, Bishop of Rochester. The Archbishop spoke briefly and briefly the Society as a body of men that could be depended upon for anything.  
Unscheduled on the breakfast program was the appearance of the Rev. William La Verendrye, R.S.M., of New York, here for the Catholic Press Convention. A Blessed Sacrament Father whose order has the special work of Nocturnal Adoration Societies. Father La Verendrye commended the Rochester society as a "very good" one and promised increased cooperation to the society.  
"We are not going to conquer the forces of Communism by a club or rubber hose," Charles A. Tucker, principal speaker, declared. "We are going to conquer by example. 1) These two writers think that the term with which Spanish Catholics should have met the Red Devil is "passive resistance" and prayer. Well, the murdered thousands who were done to death in those places where there was no armed force to defend them had no doubt said their prayers and had to be passive.  
Perhaps all Spanish Catholics should have done that only and waited until all Spain had been painted Red for you must remember 1934, the arson murder, and devastation had been proceeding for five months before Franco unsheathed the sword.  
Scripture's interpreter.  
2) The defense of this position by the two writers just named is not formally heretical, approximately to heresy, and in its implication is to be left unspoken.

dent in Berlin, not a Catholic, that appeared a week ago in the New York Times, our most representative daily.  
Public reaction to the immense publicity surrounding the trials of monks and lay brothers of the Catholic Church on immorality charges has been three-fold. Many loyal Catholics are convinced that the charges are false and that the trials are a frame up.  
"Another group of Catholics and Protestants criticize secretly the use of the trials for anti-Catholic propaganda which sometimes take on the character of downright anti-Christian propaganda."  
Nazi Enthusiasts rejoice.  
"These National Socialist enthusiasts who hate the Catholic Church as a 'foreign' institution naturally rejoice in its trial because it makes as much of the trials as they can. Elections Are Expeditious."  
A State Youth Law, mandating Youth organizations by forcing all boys and girls to join the Brown Shirt Hitler Youth.  
"Pastoral letters were issued every month protesting against the school campaign as a breach of the Concordat. Finally came the Pope's encyclical 'On Paganism' again stating the most drastic challenge yet addressed to the Nazis."  
Trust Was Broken.  
"The trust had been broken. The government threw all the imperial trials into the courts simultaneously and most of the government propaganda machine to give them the maximum publicity."  
The origin of the present campaign is a clue to what Catholicism stands to lose immediately if the state succeeds. Statistics are not available for the whole Reich, but in Prussia 1,632,000 school children out of 1,737,000 Catholics of a total age were in 1934 Catholic grammar schools. Another 600,000 in 700,000 were in Catholic schools in other parts of the Reich.  
"These 2,000,000 or so children are the immediate issue. The state does not conceal its real aim. It is that the trials will go a step toward shattering public faith in Catholic education."  
We Shall Fight.  
"There you have the story in a nutshell, and there is no guarantee that the 'anti-front' may not stretch some day into the very land. Hold your breath. The fight is to take the children away from us. If we show up in court, it is a matter now, if we bring our shoulders and waders, will maybe be in some truth in it or it is not our fight. If we won't back up the Holy Father when he travels, chance will, with our own eyes, as too will be fighting alone."
