Maryknoller Jesuit Sing First Masses

Fr. White's Mass Listed at Geneva; Fr. Miller's at St. Michael's

Two young men of this diocese to be ordained clerics will celebrate their first Solemn High Masses one in Geneva on June 27 and the other in Rochester on June 28.

They are the Rev. Richard Felix White, M. A., of Geneva, and the Rev. Walter J. Miller, S. J., son of Mrs. Agnes Burns Miller and the late Andrew J. Miller, Chief Deputy U. S. Marshal of Rochester district, who will be ordained at the Seminary of the Catholic Foreign Mission Society of America, Maryknoll, Ossining, N. Y., by the Most Rev. James Edwin Walsh, M. M., Maryknoll Superior General, and the Rev. Walter J. Miller, S. J., son of

The archbishop and engineers have a large force of workmen on the property and Bishop Gannon said he anticipates no obstacle to the opening of the Seminary in September.

The project of establishing the seminary was undertaken by the Bishops of the United States at the request of the Bishops of Mexico, where not one of the 33 dioceses is permitted to have a seminary.

Both young men were graduated from St. Michael's School, here, Aquinas Institute, and had two years at Syracuse University, N. Y. State College of Forestry. He entered the Society of Jesus on July 24, 1924, at St. Andrew-on-the-Hudson, Poughkeepsie, Philadelphical and theological studies were made at Woodstock College. He taught physics at Georgetown University and made special studies in astronomy at Georgetown College Observatory.

Before joining the Maryknoll Foreign Mission Society, Father White attended St. Stephen's School, Geneva, St. John the Evangelist School, Rochester; De Sales High School, Geneva, and Georgetown University and Maryknoll College, Clarks Summit, Pa.

Following a departure ceremony at Maryknoll, Father White will go to Eastern Asia, where his society is represented by 178 priests and brothers on foreign soil.

Dedicate 1937 Nazareth 'Lantern' to Sr. Teresina

Dedicated to Sister M. Teresina of the Sisters of St. Joseph, a member of the faculty, the jubilee edition of "Lantern," Nazareth Academy senior year book has made its appearance.

Theme of this year's book is the Sesquicentennial of the Constitution of the United States.

Open letters uniquely presented note the anniversary of the martyrdom of St. Paul, the anniversary of St. Sylvester, the 200th anniversary of the birth of Charles Carroll of Carrollton, Catholic signer of the Declaration of Independence, and the 25th anniversary of the founding of Girl Scouts of America.

Prominently featured is a tribute to the late Rev. William P. Ryan, "Friend of Nazareth Academy," written by Marie Weldman.

Photographs of the four Bishops of Rochester, faculty members, visiting retreat masters, members of the class and informal snapshots enhance the attractiveness of the book.

Well written articles, verse and accounts of Academy life during the girls' four year tenure round out the silver jubilee edition. Particular attention has been given to Catholic Action and religious activities carried on by the students.

George's Memorial Essay Contest winners, the Mantuan Roman banquet with girls in Roman costumes, and the Home Economics class are featured in pictures.
