QUESTIONS OF DAY TO BE DISCUSSED AT CLIFF HAVEN

(By N.C.W.C. News Service) CLIFF HAVEN, N. Y.—Perpetual questions of the day will be discussed by prominent lecturers at the forty-sixth annual session of the Catholic Summer School of America, which opens on July 4 here.

The program of lectures and forums will be supplemented by concerts, dramatic productions, athletics and social events. The Board of Studies is under the direction of its chairman, the Rt. Rev. Magr. Michael J. Lavalle, Vicar General of the Archdiocese of New York and Pastor of St. Patrick's Cathedral, that city.

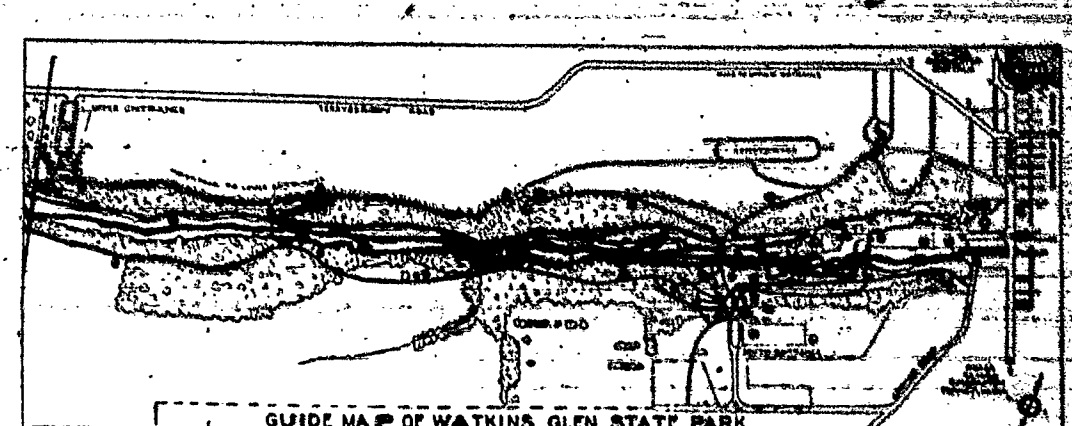
Billy Shew and his orchestra will furnish music over the week-end. Future attractions list the International Fashion Flats on the afternoon and evening of July 11.
