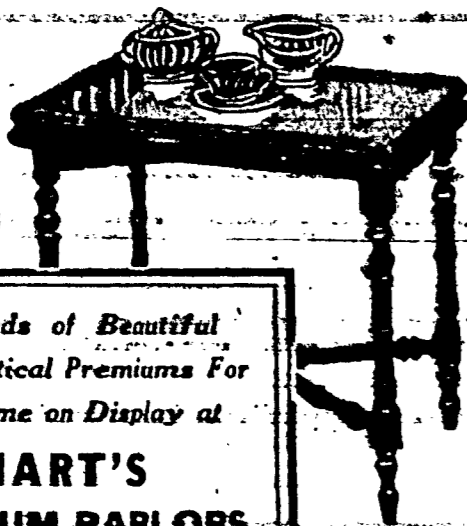

The problem of most summer cottages is to offer accommodations for a large week-end group in a comparatively small space. As the third of a series of suggestions for a summer cottage at the lake, this English bungalow is highly attractive to the person who seeks something out of the ordinary. A compact and efficient room arrangement solves both the "size" and "style" problem.

The exterior walls are of native stone while timbers and shingles fill in between the high peaked roof. Stucco, brick, log or all change colors could be used. The roof should be covered with natural wood shingles, which when weathered, take on a dark gray coloring.

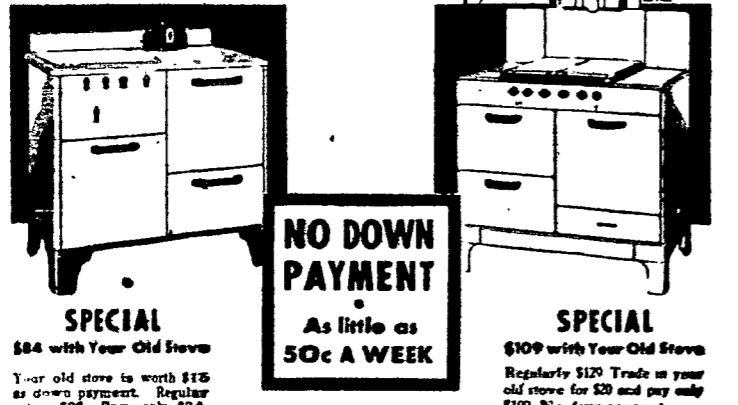
