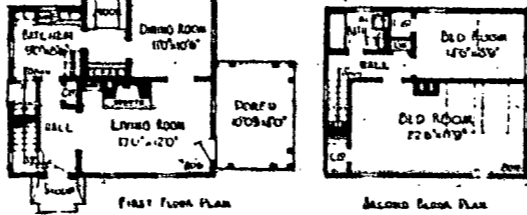

Square Type Economical

Thousands of families who postponed home ownership and contented themselves with living quarters that would do to ride out the depression have with the return of higher wages turned to home ownership.
 Many buyers are being built complete for as little as \$2,500 and under present loan requirements down payments of \$500 are all that is necessary.
 Because of the economy of construction and heating the square type of home is always superior, particularly when developed in an striking design as this attractive five room house.
 There are several reasons for this trend to home building. Possibly the most important at the present time is the fact that rents have increased more than building costs, most of which are still well below the boom level.
 Better financing also accounts for the construction of a considerable number of new homes as well for mortgages up to eighty per cent of the total value can be obtained from banks or other loan associations. The final factor in the decision to build is the great number of low cost homes being offered by the building trades.
 This square Colonial has a large living room with fireplace and built in book shelves dining room convenient breakfast nook and conveniently planned kitchen with an entrance to the basement. Two bedrooms, one of them extremely large and airy bath and three closets are on the second floor.
 An enormous demand for roomy comfortable accommodations has made possible the construction of these homes. The fact that during the past decade building has fallen off tremendously coupled with the increased birthrate and number of marriages postponed during the depression, has made it possible for contractors and builders to supply the demand by using mass production methods for the first time.

Catholics in History

STEPHEN RUSSELL MALLORY Mallory was an American statesman who, serving as United States Senator from Florida at the outbreak of the Civil War, cast his lot with the Confederacy and became secretary of the southern navy, which he created out of the raw materials of the United States. He was a member of the United States House of Representatives and served for seven years and survived many arduous campaigns. He occupied the position of probate judge in Florida, and collector of customs at Key West, before being elected to the United States Senate. He was serving his second term in the Senate at the time the war broke out.
 When he was appointed by President Jefferson Davis of the Confederacy to undertake the work of creating and organizing the southern navy, the South was entirely lacking in naval stores of any kind and had not a single armed vessel. Within the end of the war came Mallory took flight with Jefferson Davis from Richmond and subsequently was arrested at LaGrange, Georgia, where he was residing with his family. He was a prisoner for nearly a year in Fort Lafayette, on a small island in New York harbor. Following his release he returned to Florida and resumed the practice of law. He was born on the island of Trinidad, West Indies, in 1813, and died at Pensacola in 1872.

Philippine Bishops Flay Birth Control

MANILA, P. I. The birth control movement in the Philippines, given impetus by the projected visit of Mrs. Margaret Sanger, notorious American birth control advocate, as scathingly condemned in a joint pastoral letter prepared by the Philippine Catholic hierarchy.
 The letter was revealed following the four-day annual conference of Bishops, held recently at the Archbishop's House in the World City.
 The meeting was called by the Most Rev. Michael J. O'Donerty, Archbishop of Manila, to take up various pressing problems confronting the Catholic Church in the Philippines, including intensification of the Church's drive against Communism, religious instruction in public schools, a more effective Catholic Press and other related matters.
 In the pastoral birth control is assailed as contrary to the sacred institution of matrimony. The letter says that "in spite of the vivid recollection and striking indignation of religious fervor during the glorious events of the International Eucharistic Congress and above all in order that its spiritual benefits may not perish, your Bishops gathered for their annual meeting, earnestly desire to call your attention and in virtue of their present Pastoral do call your attention to an evil that, among others, constitutes a threat to the morality and uprightness of the traditional customs in the Philippines."
 "We refer to Birth Control or the limitation of birth by artificial means," the document says.
 Quoting from the Holy Father's Encyclical on Christian Marriage, the pastoral says His Holiness "has collected under these three heads the attacks of errors against the divine institution of marriage, namely errors against the offspring errors against conjugal faith errors against the holiness and dignity of the Sacrament."

BISHOP OF SAN JUAN HITS PUERTO RICO 'EUGENICS' LAWS

SAN JUAN, P. R. The eugenics laws of Puerto Rico which have just gone into effect, are assailed by not only to Christian doctrine but to natural morality by the Most Rev. Edwin Vincent Byrne, Bishop of San Juan, de la Cruz in a pastoral letter addressed to his people in this connection.
 "As Catholics," the Bishop says "it is our duty to repudiate this immoral legislation and to oppose it to the soldiers of Christ."
 Speaking with special reference to the law legalizing contraceptive propaganda and practice which went into effect on July 31, the law providing for compulsory sterilization, which went into effect August 12 and the law prohibiting matrimony to certain classes of persons, which went into effect August 13, Bishop Byrne says:
 "It is proper that legislators have always in mind that neither the prosperity of the government nor the temporal welfare of the citizens can be obtained if the moral order is very undesirable foundation, is undermined. Marriage of the family are the basis of the good government and for this reason they should be zealous protectors."
