We sympathize with Father Monroe, and we have dared to promise him that the home-town will come to his rescue.

No doubt you saw the letter of Sister M. Tarcisia, O.S.F., formerly Miss Agnes Scheid of Magoo Avenue which was published in last week's CATHOLIC COURIER. Sister Tarcisia reports the complete destruction of the Mission Station at Jamaica where she is located. The work and sacrifice of thirty years is in ruins. Unless help can be found they will be compelled to abandon their mission.
