Boston's See Schools Save City \$10,000,000

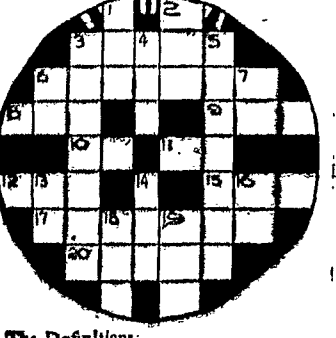

This is basketball week in the puzzle column, and you'll have to be pretty clever at handling the ball below to score well with it.



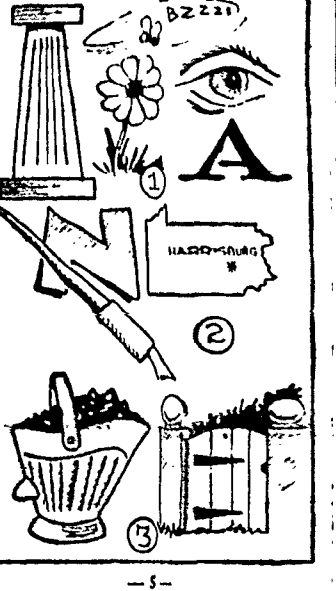

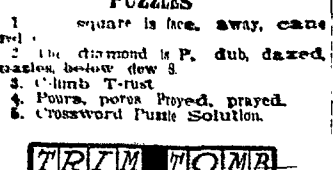
