Hits War Propaganda Of Aliens

Fr. Cox Warns Nation Against Advocates of 'Parallel Action'

NEW YORK. The United States has become a prey to foreign propagandists who are slowly but surely dragging America into war, the Rev. Ignatius W. Cox, S.J., Professor of Ethics at Fordham University, warned in an address at the Catholic Press Exhibit at the Centre Club here.

These propagandists have been successful in stimulating parallel action in the so-called democratic countries, the United States, England, France and Soviet Russia, he declared.

Father Cox assailed Soviet Russia, in particular. The Soviets he charged, are getting a powerful influence by bringing the United States into war on the side of the so-called democracies.

Instead of that, he continued, we are being drawn into the dangerous paths of international power politics, the balance of power policy, discredited as assured way to war.

We have been told that one-third of our nation is improperly fed, clothed and housed. We are, in spite of that, preparing to abandon our peaceful efforts for economic and financial security at home, to pursue under the hypocritical headlines brewed by imaginative militarists, at the cost of billions of dollars in non-productive industries.

'Reds' Shifting Tactics, Warns Msgr. Sheen

Communism To Day Is 'Trojan Horse' Tactics Changed But Purpose of World Revolution Same, Says Noted Speaker on 'Catholic Hour'

NEW YORK. "Communism today is a 'Trojan Horse,' wheeled into unsuspecting groups in this country under the guise of a peaceful United Front. Communism has changed its tactics, but not its ends.

His warning was sounded by the Most Rev. Msgr. Fulton J. Sheen, Sunday night in his radio address over the "Catholic Hour" broadcast by the National Council of Catholic Men on a nation-wide NBC hook-up.

Monsignor Sheen said that "Communism has changed its tactics, but not its end or purpose; namely, the revolutionary overthrow of the existing order." It has adopted the strategy of the United Front, he declared, which, in "disguised language," is "the wolf in sheep's clothing."

He quoted from Communist sources to prove that Communists are urged to wheel their Trojan horse into our labor unions, religious organizations, political parties, athletic associations and other groups of the United Front, until they can tear off their mask and throw this country into a barbarous civil war such as they have instigated in Spain, so that they may emerge victorious and thus exterminate their beloved Comrade Stalin.

Greatest Humbug. Calling Communism "Soviet Fascism," Monsignor Sheen said it is "the greatest humbug ever foisted on the American people." "The tactics," he added, "are designed only to deceive."

Give Gold and Gems For Ostensorium

NEW ORLEANS. Gold, silver and gems, ranging from dimes to chalices, a pectoral cross and a Bishop's ring, have been collected for the making of the ostensorium that will be carried in processions and used when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed at the Eighth National Eucharistic Congress to be held in New Orleans in October.

For months the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women has been collecting the material and it is said have a total membership of 2,000. The material will be required for the making of the ostensorium.

Jewelers have estimated the value of the gold, silver and gems at \$20,000 and the original value of the articles at \$100,000. The pectoral cross and the Bishop's ring belonged to the late Msgr. J. Francis Prim pastor of St. Elizabeth's Church in New Orleans, who had the privilege of wearing them as an archbishop-elect.
