rather in the name of the parents. "Once we understand the true relation of the state to elementary and secondary education, the article continues, 'the position of private and parochial schools becomes clear. Since the aim of the state is to secure an educational public, any school contributing to this end must, in a sense, be considered as a part of the system of public education. The grounds, then, on which Catholics claim a share of the money collected for public education becomes clear. The state imposes compulsory education laws and collects money from the public at large in order to assure itself of an adequate educational system for all children. The means employed by Catholic parents for the education of their children are performing this service for the state. They are entitled to some share in school money as a compensation for the service rendered."

Expressing the belief that if a change could be effected in the light of the principles set forth, it would be an improvement over the present system, Dr. Ryan says it would emphasize the function of the state in education, would serve as a check upon the entrance of the state into a realm it should not invade, namely, the mind of its citizens, would help to the attainment of religious freedom, insofar as it affects education, would introduce a measure of economy in education.

High Standards Win Certificate For Staub Cleaner

Another valuable safeguard is added to the consumer movement in the formation of the Institute for Maintaining Dry Cleaning Standards of the United States and Canada. William J. Staub of Staub & Son, Inc. By a system of uniform unannounced inspections by independent qualified technicians, this recently formed institute will give a national service in certifying dry cleaning plants which maintain safe and sanitary standards. The condition of the cleaning solvent will be laboratory analyzed every month and test bundles will be sent to the dry cleaner at unannounced intervals. Certified dry cleaners must carry full insurance to protect customers' goods against loss or damage and must pledge to settle promptly any reasonable complaint. Mr. Staub, whose plant just received the award of Certification from the Institute states that in his opinion this new plan for establishing standards for dry cleaning will provide protection for the consumer as fixed and controlled as those for weights and measures.

METHODISTS PRESENT ANTI-CATHOLIC PETITION

BUENOS AIRES - A Methodist Congress just here has concluded its sessions by addressing a petition to the Minister of Justice and Public Instruction protesting against "religious instruction in schools and educational institutions and diverse civic activities of the country on the part of the Roman Catholic Church." The petition invokes an article of the Constitution which promises freedom of conscience and religion. It says that the "religious and teaching catechism have been introduced and the Church is endeavoring to bring about the teaching of religion in the schools of the Capital."

Russian Atheists Urge Force

RIGA, LATVIA - (NC) - Russian atheists themselves testify anew to the persecution of religion in the U.S.S.R. by calling for armed action against the "old believers." A recent issue of "Izvestia" says that these "old believers" have a better system of communication than the Soviets themselves; that although they are living along the Volga, in the forests of the Ural, and in Siberia, they have a headquarters in Moscow and are in constant communication with it. The article states, in describing the "old believers," that "their bishops are all adventurers and corrupt persons" and that armed action should be put and to these elements of insidious action."
