BISHOP STRESSES THREE POINTS In Talk To 300 Auburn Socialists

AUBURN—An impressive service was given on Sunday morning, in Holy Family Church of Auburn, in which over three hundred young women representing the local parish sodalities attended Mass and received Holy Communion.

The celebrant of the Mass was His Excellency, the Most Rev. James E. Keane, Bishop of the Rochester diocese.

Immediately after Mass, all Sodality members of the Holy Family Auditorium were given Communion breakfast was served. The program opened with the singing of "Mother Dearest, Mother Fairest" by the entire group.

Miss Jane Baker, president of the Auburn Sodality Union, introduced the Rev. Dean John A. Conway, pastor of Holy Family Church who in turn presented Bishop Keane.

If consistent, people give good example at all times, by their reading, attendance at movies, places of amusement, etc. in other words, actions speak louder than words.

To increase intelligence, Sodality should read Catholic magazines and literature so that they may better understand and practice Catholic doctrine.

Miss Baker expressed her appreciation to the Sodality members who had co-operated to make the breakfast a success, and to Dean Conway and the Holy Family Church for their hospitality.
