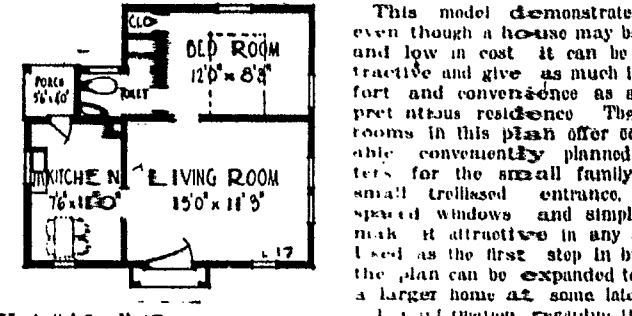

(Continued from Page 2) The State K. C. approved the proposal of the Catholic Press Campaign inaugurated by the committee to bring a Catholic newspaper into the home of every Knight of Columbus.

Thomas A. Madden, N. Y. State Chairman of the Legislative Committee reported that the committee would prevent persons from holding office either by election or appointment or civil service examination, who believed in the use of force and violence to overthrow the government of the United States.

The convention endorsed the establishment of an organization to be known as "Deceit in Print" whose purpose shall be to purge the newspapers and magazines and book-selling places of indecent publications.

The convention ended with a banquet tendered to the delegates and visiting Knights of Columbus and their ladies by the local council.
