Miss Cecilia M. Newman, our Diocesan President, and National Chairman of the Committee on Industrial Problems N. C. C. W., is back from Washington with an enthusiastic report on the Institute on Industry which was held there last week at the National Catholic School of Social Service.

Rev. August Burns of St. Bernard's Seminary was also in attendance.

We feel too that we can claim for the Rochester diocese, Miss Jane McElroy of Geneva, who was one of the representatives from St. Xavier College, Buffalo.

The Institute attracted an attendance of thirty-five from shops, factories, offices and colleges, from Washington, Chicago, Milwaukee, Louisville, Toledo, Dayton, Cleveland, Pittsburgh, Baltimore, Buffalo and Rochester.

Great credit is due Miss Linda E. Bessette, Field Secretary of the Social Action Department of the National Catholic Welfare Conference, who arranged for the Institute.

Dr. Edward Professor of Economics, School of Social Sciences, Catholic University of America, gave daily lectures on Social Legislation.

Miss Vincent Ferrer, O.F., Professor of Economics, Rosary College, River Forest, Ill., lectured daily on the Wage Problem, while Dr. Elizabeth Morley, Professor of Economics, Notre Dame College, Baltimore, gave a course on the Labor Movement.

All these lectures were followed by discussion and questions. Additional lectures were given by Rev. Fr. Francis J. Haas, Dean of the School of Social Sciences, Catholic University of America; Elizabeth Christman, Executive Secretary, National Women's Trade Union League, Washington, D. C.; Rev. John A. Ryan, D. D., Director of the Social Action Department, N. C. W. C.; Rev. R. A. McGowan, Assistant Director of the Social Action Department, N. C. W. C.; Mary Anderson, Chief of Women's Bureau, U. S. Department of Labor, Washington, D. C.; and Dr. John Francis Cronin, S. S., Professor of Economics, St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, Md.

At Nazareth was left free for discussion, reading and sight-seeing. Miss Agnes G. Regan, Executive Secretary of the National Council of Catholic Women gave a talk of the opening and also the formal closing of the Institute.
