

MARRIAGES MUST BE PRESERVED

As Acts of Religion Says Bishop Hunt

NEW YORK (NC)—"Marriages must be brought back and preserved as acts of religion," declared the Most Rev. Duane G. Hunt, Bishop of Salt Lake, Sunday night in the last address of his current series over the "Catholic Hour."

Speaking on the Sacrament of Marriage, Bishop Hunt said that "with the ever increasing divorce broken homes and neglected children, our society is threatened with ruin." It is about time, he added, "that we submitted this subject to honest and logical reasoning."

But, he added, "it would seem that there is a conspiracy in our midst to bring about one single end the freedom of men and women to enter and to break marriage relationships as they please, regardless of everything else. It is at this point that reason rebels."

Written in Nature's Book The elementary laws governing marriage come from nature and from God that marriage is the union of one man and one woman in a permanent and exclusive relationship.
