Declares Cardinal At England Rounion

LONDON—'It is inexplicable how English Catholics can wisely and safely adopt the label Fascist," declared His Eminence Arthur Cardinal Hisley when speaking at the 83rd annual reunion of Birmingham Catholics held in the fown Hall there.

"Because the Chief is anti-Communist she is not therefore pro-Fascist," said Heis Eminence, who added: "Fascism, National Socialism and Communism she corademns equally.


