Projansky Celebrates 25th Business Anniversary

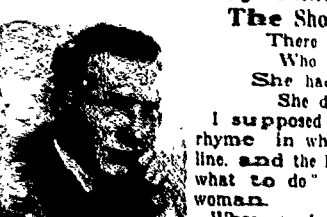
