Rally To Bring Famed Catholic Layman

PAUL McGUIRE WILL ADDRESS OPEN RALLY

To Give World Report On Catholic Action

Paul McGuire, internationally known exponent of Catholic Action, will be the featured speaker at the Knights of Columbus Open Rally for Christian Justice, Thursday evening, April 23, in Columbus Civic Centre ballroom.

On the occasion of the Christian Revolution, the rally will begin at 8:15 P. M. and the program will include numbers by the Knights of Columbus Choral Society. Mr. McGuire, a native of Australia, will be presented by Dr. James N. Eastham of Nazareth College faculty and chairman of the Rochester knights' Catholic Activities Committee.

On a nation-wide tour for the Supreme Council, Knights of Columbus, Mr. McGuire has literally travelled around the world in his study of Catholic Action. He has gone from his native Australia where, with a Dominican priest, he was founder of the Catholic Guild for Social Studies, to other parts of the world seeking information he will disseminate in 1937, and early in 1938, he was in Spain as a member of the Duke of Wellington's Committee for the Reparation of the Basque children. He came to Rochester in March 1938 and in an address to the students of St. Bernard's Seminary predicted at that time that Franco would win the civil war. He was brought to the city by Edward J. Byrne of the seminary faculty who is serving on the rally committee.

Msgr. Brophy's Death Is Widely Mourned

June 8, 1895 at the hands of the late Most Rev. Bishop Bernard J. McQuaid. First assignment was a professor at St. Andrew's Seminary in June of that same year.

It was on June 8, 1898 that the then Father Brophy was named pastor of what was to become St. Monica's Church, an outstanding parish in the diocese, under his zealous and able guidance. Humble Beginning. With but lean resources and 65 families, Father Brophy began his pastorate in what over a span of forty years, there has been built a complete church plant and in which now are served over 5,000 souls.

The present church seating 1,200 and an excellent example of church architecture, the first church now used as a school, the rectory and community hall have all been built under the supervision of Monsignor Brophy. Throughout his long pastorate, Monsignor Brophy has had the willing and wholehearted support of his parishioners, many of whom still living, pioneered with him in the parish's founding.

It was a memorable occasion for the beloved pastor and his parishioners when on December 15, took place on the 40th anniversary of the parish, the burning of the \$10,000 first mortgage on the church. There came to rejoice with Monsignor Brophy on that occasion, His Excellency Bishop Kearney, Mayor Lester E. Rapp and Patrick J. Slavin, director of city parks and trustee of the parish for the last 10 years.

Franco's Actions Seen As Christian In Dealing With War Criminality

NEW YORK—Up to the present, on the basis of press dispatches, the "Christian virtues have been professed and practiced" in National Spain regarding action against those charged with crimes in connection with the Spanish civil war.

The distinguished member of the Royal Air Force told me last July in Burgos that the documentary evidence for the number of murderers I have cited is still in the archives of responsible British officials, diplomatic, military and political. Competent historians of the Spanish civil war will not overlook this material. Incidentally, it may help to explain the much-criticized policy of Prime Minister Neville Chamberlain with reference to the strife in Spain now happily ended.

"Among the unfair innuendoes to which I would draw attention, I will mention one: 'It is not alone General Franco whom the world watches today but also the Catholic Church.'"

"This remarkable utterance is bruited abroad at a time when the New York Times and other metropolitan journals are offering general commendations to His Holiness Pius XII, on his enlightened policies vis-a-vis the totalitarian tyrannies of Nazi Germany, Fascist Italy, Lethal Mexico and Soviet Russia. Why, therefore, the diplomatic corps of the Vatican, which is represented in Burgos by one of the ablest members of the service, His Excellency, the Most Rev. Archbishop Cesare Cavigliani, would suffer in silence the 'brutal legal execution of two million criminals on an alleged 'black list'?"
