BUFFALO. (NC) - Churches and synagosgues were urged to assert their claims for more of the leisuare time of chaldren, in an address delivered by Arthur L. Swift. Jr., director of student field work the Union Teological Seminary of New York City. He spoke at the Church Correference of Social Work held here, declaring that extra-curricular activities in the public chools are depriving children of heir religious education.

"The exclusion by law of religion from our public schools is tanta-mount to the denial to religion of any real poart in the education of the masses of American boys and girls," he said. "This is especially true since the school system has come to pre-empt in various extra-curracular activities so much of the leave the circurch but little time for heir religious education
