The dancers at Enna Jettick Park are thoroughly enjoying the music and very special entertainment features provided under the direction of versatile Benny Meroff.

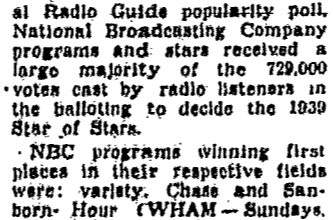
