Over the radio, on the screen, in the papers we see nothing but WAR. What really is War? For that answer I would like to quote the stirring words of Mr. Shafer as they appeared in the Congressional Record:

Blaring bands, martial airs, gaudy uniforms, ringing cheers, the rhythm of marching feet... Long months of agony of waiting for some word whether those loved ones still live in the fields of Europe exist mud and water, the vermin and stench of the trenches—no sleep, no food, no shelter, no light, no sound, no rest, no peace.

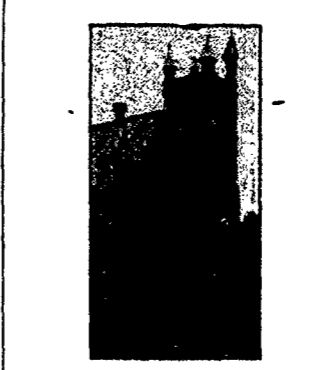
