It becomes perfectly clear that most city people think of the country as it was years ago.

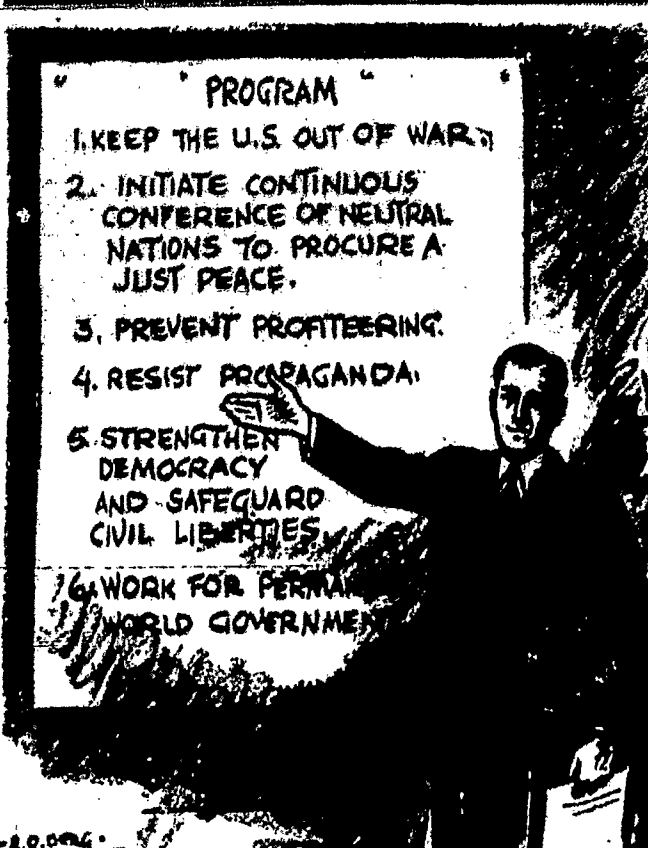
