NAZIS USE OLD HINDENBURG DECREE TO BAN CATHOLICS

ANTWERP.—The Nazis have used a decree of the late President Von Hindenburg to suppress the Frauenhilfswerk fur Priesterberufe, organization for the foster-ing of vocations to the priesthood by prayers and offerings.

The blanket order, issued by Von Hindenburg, was given out the day the Reichstag was burned in 1933 and was intended to com-bat Communism only. Now Himmler has used it against an organization founded by Princess Immacuiata Herzogin su Sachsen and which had a membership of 50,000. The decree is published in the Gaset van Antwerpen.


