## **U. S. Bishops Thank Pope For Encyclicals**

WASHINGTON (NC) Voicing profound gratitude to His Holiness Pope Pius XII for his Encyclical Letter Sertum Lactitiae, marking the sesquicentennial of the establishment of the American Hierarchy, and likewise for the Holy Father's Encyclical Summi Pontificatus and his radio message to the Catholic University's semicentennial celebrations, the Arch-bishops and Bishops of the United States have declared that these expressions by the Sovereign Pontiff "cannot but do immeasurable good," and that they are resolved to bring the Encyclicals "to every Catholic home and as far as pos-sible also to those not of the household of the faith."

This expression of gratitude and this resolve are embodied in a letter dispatched to Pope Pius XII in the name of the American Histarchy. Appended to the letter are the signatures of His Emi-nence William Cardinal O'Connell Archbishop of Boston His Eminence Dennis Cardinal Dougherty Archbishop of Philadelphia the Most Rev Michael J Curley.
