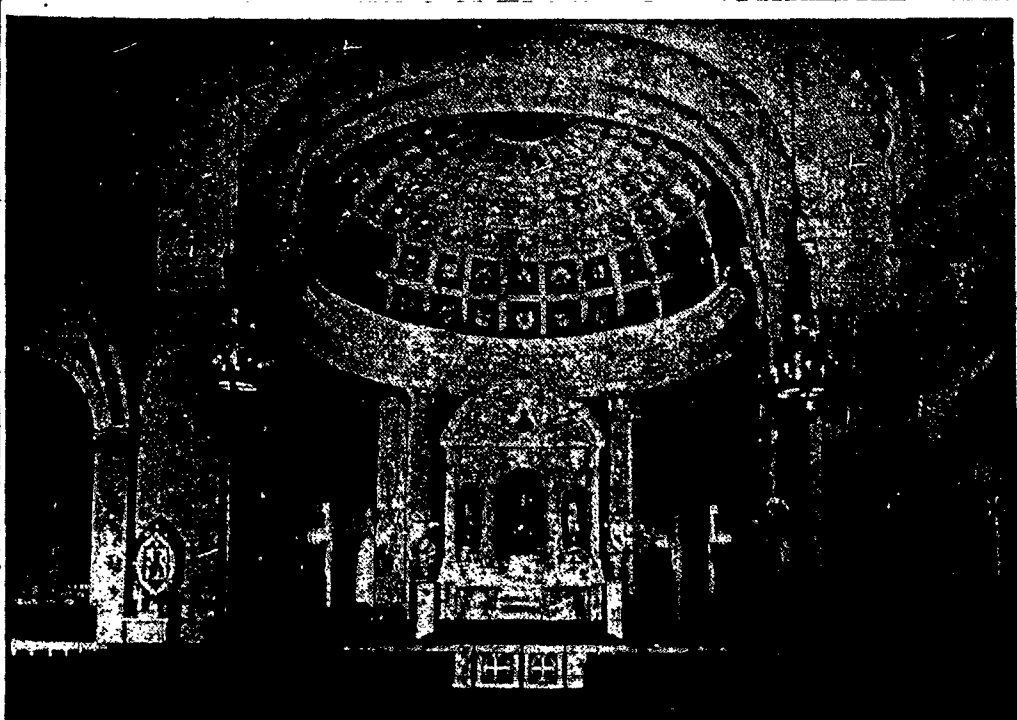


Church As Newly Decorated For Silver Jubilee Observance
