Four Cardinals of 1584 Have Ascended To Papacy

Nineteen Cardinals were created et the Christmas Consistory held on December 12, 1584, by Pope

on December 12, 1584, by Pope Gregory XIII,

Four of these Cardinals succeeded to the Papacy, Cardinal John Baptist, Castagna became Pope Urban-VII, who occupied the Chair of Pefer for only 18 days. Cardinal Nicholas Sfrondati, elswated at the same Consistory, succeeded as Pope Gregory XIV. The latter lived only fon months after his election, and Cardinal John Anthony Parchinetti, elevated to the Cardinalate at the same time, succeeded to the Papal throne and took the name of Innocent IX. He died only two months later. Then, after Pope Clement VII had reigned for 13 years, the fourth of the Cardinals created in the 1584 assended the Papal throne. He was Cardinal Alexander de Medici, who become Pope Lee, XI, the last of a need family that stready had given the Church Popes Lee, XI, Cheriatt of a need family that stready had given the Church Popes Lee X. Chement, VIII and Pius IV. His Pontificate lasted only II days.


