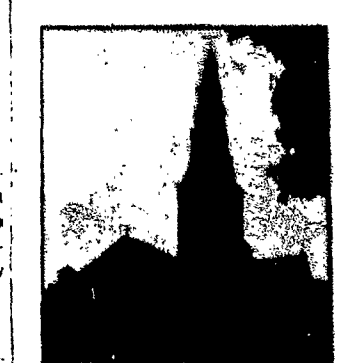


The Congregation of Rites, meeting in the presence of Pope Pius XII, has just approved a decree for the beatification of Mother Philippine Rose Duchesne.

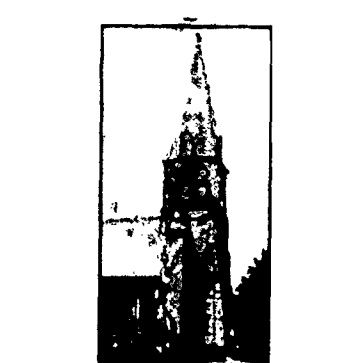
