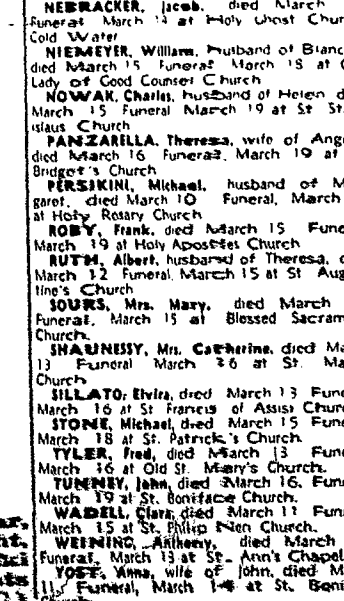
ALUMNAE MEET
