INTERNATIONAL WARNING ON VATICAN NEWS MEXICO'S SUBVERSIVE PROBLEM DENY REPORT OF PAPAL REFUGE Warn of Devious News on Vatican (NY N. C. W. G. News Service) Flat denial, the one from Washington showing some irritation, followed quickly the secular press report that President Roosevelt, through Milton C. Taylor, his personal representative at the Vatican, had offered His Holiness Pope Pius XII refuge in the United States. The report was carried in a United Press dispatch from Rome.

WASHINGTON, June 7 (NY)—Speaking after he had talked with the President himself, White House Secretary Stephen Early was vigorous in his denial of the report that President Roosevelt had offered refuge in the United States to His Holiness Pope Pius XII. Declaring that "there is absolutely no truth in it whatever," Mr. Early asserted that newspapers were spreading a lot of money for circulation from Rome for sensationalism by the American public. He said these erroneous reports from Rome had spread throughout the United States and had probably stirred up a lot of religious bitterness.

Along The War Front Gen. Weygand's Trust In Spiritual Cited PARES (NY)—Like the great Marshal Foch, his disciple Gen. Maxime Weygand Commander of the Allied Armies, has always evinced and acclaimed his religious faith. An incident of last summer at the Dourmery ceremony, at which His Eminence Rodrigue Cardinal Villeneuve, Archbishop of Quebec, presided as Papal Legate, recalled Gen. Weygand and represented the Academie Française. When he spoke during the ceremony, he quoted the statement of Gabriel Hantouas made in 1914 with regard to St. Joan of Arc: "We are only at the dawn of the days that will see her mission accomplished indefinitely."

Leftist Lauds Faith As Only 'Entity' Left 'FIFTH COLUMN' GIVES MEXICO THE JITTERS MEXICO CITY.—(NY)—Communist propaganda activities of Spanish refugees, anonymous threats to various Spanish and German groups here, and the attempted assassination of Leon Trotsky have added to the already considerable amount of "jitters" regarding "fifth column" agencies in Mexico. Spanish refugees have been distributing pamphlets praising the Soviet press as the "defender of the proletariat" and "Quintan Roo," which state that the Soviet Union has 3,700 dailies, of which 224 are published in 70 languages other than Russian—proclaim that the Russian press has educated and continues to educate the people. Special guards have been placed by the Inspection of Police at the Casino Espanol, La Carolina textile mill, the Ruzicki Company and the factory of Becker & Co., a German firm, all of which had received anonymous threats.

PONTIFF RECEIVES 300 NEWLY MARRIED COUPLES VATICAN CITY.—Receiving some 300 newly married couples in audience on Wednesday, His Holiness Pope Pius XII ranked this month as the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart, and said it offered the opportunity to consecrate new families to Him Who is the source of all virtues and the support of all duties and sacrifices of human life. The only allusion His Holiness made to the war was to say that this moment is so troubled that it is difficult to find an epoch rich when it is possible for two human hearts mutually to live in peace and tranquility.

Jehovah's Witnesses Halted In Philippines Manila.—A small but determined and vociferous band of "Jehovah's Witnesses" have been active in Manila and suburbs of late. The Witnesses use portable loudspeakers, "Watch Tower" pamphlets, and records of "Judge Rutherford's" speeches in their proselytizing campaign among the Catholic masses. The campaign has made little headway.

Old Tricks Mark Soviet Anti-God Policy In Poland The "lecture" or propaganda, method of some 25,000 godless agitators sent into Poland apparently has had little effect, since, it is reported here, pressure is being applied which approximates the older policy as practiced in Russia. It is true that there seems to be some respect for the "freedom" of Poles to the atheistic efforts and so far the authorities have not resorted to open and general persecutory measures. But other means are employed to sway the people. For instance, some sources report official assistance in finding employment unless he joins the League of the Godless. There has been no prohibition on religious services, but an effort is being made to create an impression of amounting opposition on the part of the ruling powers and thus to create an atmosphere of constraint.

Portuguese-Vatican Concordat Ratified VATICAN CITY.—Ratification of the Concordat between the Holy See and Portugal was signalled by an exchange of telegrams between Dr. Antonio de Oliveira Salazar, Premier of Portugal, and His Eminence Luigi Cardinal Maglione, Papal Secretary of State. The President of Portugal conferred upon Cardinal Maglione the decoration of the Grand Cross of the Tower and Sword. A Concordat between the Holy See and Portugal and an agreement relating to Portugal in Portuguese-controlled territory were signed on May 7 in the apartment of Cardinal Maglione at the Vatican.

Belgian Royalty Reported In England LONDON.—The Belgian royal children are in England and not in Italy, it is reported by the French Ministry of Information in a message received here. Earlier news stated that Prince Baudouin and his sister and brother were sent to Italy to stay with their aunt, the Princess of Piedmont.

Offer Masses For Fallers Of Flanders LONDON.—Two solemn Masses, presided by His Eminence, Cardinal Humeau, Archbishop of Westminster, were celebrated here over the week-end in Westminster Cathedral—one for those who fell in the Battle of Flanders and the second Thanksgiving for the deliverance of the British Expeditionary Force from the Nazi trap in Belgium. The Cardinal declared in a statement that he joined in a National Day of Entreaties and our prayers were answered in God's good way. "God should have first place in our thanksgiving," he added. "By His protecting strength our men have won through to Rome."
