Along The War Front

Foreign Officials Of Rota Move

VATICAN CITY—A French Cardinal and French and English officials of the Sacred Roman Rota, together with diplomats of Allied countries accredited to the Holy See, moved from Rome into Vatican City following Italy's declaration of war on France and England.

His Eminence Eugenio Cardinal Tisserant, Secretary of the Sacred Congregation for the Oriental Church, who is a native of Nancy, France, has moved into Vatican City. He formerly made his residence in the Via Navarre Marcella in Rome.

In addition to the French and Polish ambassadors and the British Minister to the Holy See, those moving from Rome to Vatican City have included Monsignor Andrea Julliani of France and Monsignor William Theodore Heard of England, Auditor of the Sacred Roman Rota.

U. S. Envoy Prayed In Paris Cathedral

In reporting the narrow escape of United States Ambassador William C. Bullitt from a German bomb, L'Espresso, Paris daily, reported that the American Ambassador knelt at his bedside in Notre Dame Cathedral on May 13, the day of national supplication.

French Soldiers Carry Bl. Sacrament Canopy

LONDON.—Six French soldiers, four of them priests, carried the canopy in an open air procession of the Blessed Sacrament at Chartres, near Glasgow, when 8,000 members of the Catholic Young Men's Society from all Scotland processions into their annual pilgrimage and prayed for peace.

Envoy's Son Aided By Priest To Escape

WASHINGTON.—Diplomatic circles here have been informed that a priest aided Robert van der Straeten-Ponthoz, son of the Belgian Ambassador to the United States, to escape death from strafing German planes in the recent Battle of Flanders.

Crucifix Placed Above Every Bed

HAVANA.—A campaign in Cuba to have a crucifix placed above every bed in hospitals and institutions in Cuba has brought to light the fact that the Clinica Lourdes, an infirmary conducted by the Operations Medicine of Guanabacoa, was the first to adopt this practice.

Expand Hospital Work In Hong Kong

HONG KONG.—Recent additions to two Catholic hospitals in the colony, St. Francis' and St. Theresa's, each of which are in the same direct attention to the considerable work that is being done for the sick, especially the sick poor, by the religious institutions.
