Diocesan and the Sculptors in the reign of Diocletian there lived at Rome the clever sculptor whose works of art had obtained for them a high place in the Emperor's favor.

About this time Diocletian was engaged in the erection of a costly edifice, and as he was anxious that the decoration should be as perfect as possible, sent for the five sculptors to execute the difficult piece of carving which was to ornament the front of the building.

After a short time the Emperor came to watch the progress of the work. He found the carving complete, with the exception of the vacant space which was to be occupied with the image of the pretended deity.

"Sire," replied they, "we are Christians, and we are not permitted by our religion to execute any work which may contribute to the superstitious worship of idols."

The Emperor enraged, ordered them to be delivered up to the judge, to whom he gave strict orders to use every effort to induce them to retract their faith, but he might not, by their martyrdom, the services of such skilled workmen.

The judge displayed before their eyes the most frightful instruments of torture, and strove by alternate threats and promises to induce them to submit to the Emperor's will.
