St. Michael's Plans Golden Jubilee

Pontifical Mass To Mark Anniversary Of Church Dedication

St. Michael's Church in Clinton Avenue North will celebrate the 75th anniversary of the dedication of its present magnificent edifice at a pontifical High Mass on Sunday, Sept. 29, and evening with a parish banquet on Wednesday, Oct. 7.

The Most Rev. James E. Kearney, Bishop of Rochester, will pontificate at the High Mass on the feast of St. Michael on Sunday, Sept. 29, at 11 o'clock. This ceremony will be held just fifty years to the very day that the late Bishop McQuaid dedicated the church on Sept. 29, 1890.

Bishop Kearney will preach the jubilee sermon. Unformed delegations and representatives of the various church societies will march in a procession preceding the Mass. Fr. Horack, Superior.

The Rev. Arthur F. Horack, pastor of St. Michael's is supervising arrangements for the celebration. On Monday, Sept. 30, Mass will be celebrated at 8 A. M. for the children of St. Michael's with the Rev. Richard T. Brennan, pastor of neighboring St. Bridget's Church, preaching the sermon. On Tuesday, Oct. 1, at 8 A. M., a requiem High Mass will be offered by the pastor for all deceased members of the parish.

The closing event of the celebration, the parish banquet, will be held in the Bausch & Lomb auditorium on Wednesday evening, Oct. 7. Following the banquet, an old-fashioned reception will be held for all members and former members of the parish.

Presets who have served as assistants at St. Michael's in former years and boys of the parish who have been ordained to the priesthood will assist at the High Mass and be present at other events on the jubilee program.

St. Michael's Church is regarded as one of the finest examples of Gothic architectural work in this section of the country. Bishop McQuaid laid the cornerstone for the present edifice on May 27, 1888, and dedicated the completed church on Sept. 29, 1890.

The most striking features of the new church is the 20 foot tower which spirals its way into the heavens and has become one of Rochester's distinctive landmarks.

Out of Town Speakers
The Rev. Alfred Barrett, S.J., associate editor of the Sacred Heart Messenger, told the Power and Secret of the Catholic Post at a high school sectional meeting in the afternoon. W. B. Spilling is a joy was expressed by Mother M. Emmanuel, O.S.L., of the Bronx, an authority on spelling and author of the Emmanuel Speller used in Catholic schools.

Practice of "popping up" assemblies by songs that are hits with the children but are inferior as real music, was frowned upon by the Rev. Benedict Donagan, professor of music at St. Bernard's Seminary in a sectional meeting. In the category denounced he listed particular songs which he termed "vulgar" and one containing patriotic sentiment he classified as "ritzy" from the standpoint of its cultural value.

Manuscript writing, a printed form to replace the traditional script or cursive writing introduced in the first year of Catholic schools this year, was a topic for group discussion.

In the closing address His Excellency, Bishop Kearney emphasized the definite contribution which can be made to the spiritual advancement of children coming under the care of those who have devoted their lives to religion. Urging that secular subjects be not neglected, His Excellency said:

"We must give these young people who come to us something more than is in the textbook, something which comes only from being close to Jesus Christ."

Fr. Duffy presided.

Presiding at the sessions throughout the day was the Rev. John M. Duffy, diocesan superintendent of Catholic Schools. At the closing session, the Rev. Charles J. Mahoney, assistant superintendent, offered this resolution of greetings to Sister M. Marcella, principal of Nazareth Academy, prevented by serious illness from attendance:

"The teachers of the 10th Diocesan Conference extend to you sincere good wishes and fervent prayers."

The resolution was adopted and read by Sister Marcella the same day. Sister's reply is carried elsewhere in this issue.

Solemn Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament with Bishop Kearney officiating brought the successful Institute to a close. Assisting the Bishop were the Rev. Charles J. Mahoney, assistant superintendent of Catholic Schools and the Rev. John H. O'Leone, C.S.B., host to the Institute.

treatment of side walls the effort is being made to bring out the beauty of the architectural detail.

The ceiling decoration has been divided by plaster ribs into large and small sections. The smaller panels are enriched with lines of color and a stenciled decoration and alternate with larger and planer panels.

The sanctuary ceiling has been glazed in gold and decorated with decorative angles in rich colors. The blue field is covered with a pattern of stars and has an emblem of the Blessed Virgin.

Remodeling of the altar to make it liturgically correct is taking place. There will be a free-standing tabernacle. The back of the altar is so designed that it forms a setting for a beautiful statue of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel with small adoring angels on each side of the figure.

Back of the figure of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is a vase shaped nimbus of gold rays. Over the altar is a canopy and from it are draped the flowers enriched with orphreys of red velvet on gold fabric.

Many changes in the side altars in the placing of statues and additional painted and stenciled decorations which are all incomplete are included in the plans.

Objects of interest to parishioners and visitors, Sunday, will be also the refurbished rectory and convent on Ontario St. The entire side parish plant will soon be in excellent condition, Father Aziz said this week.
