According To The Doctor: A Scotch physician fully appreciating the importance of proper breathing has written a valuable little book entitled "Shut Your Mouth and Save Your Life".

The hygiene of respiration demands breathing through the nostrils rather than the mouth. On account of the projections of the turbinate bones and the processes into each nasal passage and the roundabout way the air takes in passing through the nose instead of the mouth, nasal breathing brings the air in contact with a much larger extent of moist and warm mucous membrane than does mouth breathing.

In the habitual mouth breather, the nasal mucous membrane, from lack of stimulus of cold air, dries and shrinks, causing discomfort, and since in its dry condition, the circulation easily becomes obstructed, there is predisposition to congestion and catarrhal nasal affections injury to hearing.

Nun Canoes To Distant Outpost: She went there first to attend a jubilee celebration of the Order and then was to go by train, boat and canoe to the new post at Norway House, nearly 500 miles from Winnipeg. The final stages were to be by canoe.

Norway House is a community of about 1,000 population, most of whom are Canadian Indians. At one time the settlement was one of the chief outposts of the Canadian Northwest Mounted Police and was a Hudson Bay trading post.
