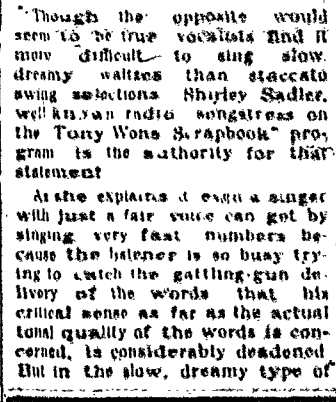
Organizations Deplore Parade Demonstration
