St. Mary's To Build New Hospital

St. Mary's Hospital, oldest institution for the care of the sick, was founded in 1857 by the Sisters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul with their Motherhouse at Emmitsburg, Maryland. With a humble beginning the Sisters began their ministrations to the sick in two small stables at the location historically known as "Bull's Head" in their distinctive religious garb the Sisters went about the city asking alms for their work. A year later they were able to build a two-story structure connecting with the two stables.

Care for 8000 Soldiers

It was in 1859 that the three-story building, now the hospital's exact wing was built. During the Civil War the fame of the Sisters of Charity spread as they cared for 6,000 soldiers between 1861 and 1865. Members of the congregation during that period became widely known for their deeds on the battlefields. A fire on Feb. 15, 1891, destroyed the interior of the hospital. Three hundred patients were saved. The fire, however, failed to weaken the stout stone walls. By September of that year, the hospital had been rebuilt and reoccupied. The Nurses' Training School was organized in 1901, with the first class being graduated in 1904. Down through the years improvements were added as the growing need arose. The operating pavilion was built in 1906; a contagious building in 1909; the maternity department in 1903 and the beautiful chapel in 1906. The new Nurses' Home was dedicated in 1923 by the Most Rev. Thomas F. Hickey, D.D., second Bishop of Rochester, following a successful campaign for \$24,000. Knights of Columbus have new forms of insurance.
