Noel Desserts Are Tasty Season Treats

KISSES OR MERINGUES
For the crunchy pyramid-shaped meringues so delicious, often used as a raft for ice cream, you'll find them easy to make but expensive to buy. Beat 4 whites of eggs until stiff and dry using a good sized bowl but in a cup granulated sugar when the mixture looks glossy add a scant 1/2 cup of sugar. Drop by teaspoons on cookie sheet, covers with buttered paper keep 2 inches apart. Bake in slow oven 35 min. May be colored green or red to add color for the holidays.

CRANBERRY ICE
1 qt. cranberries
2 cups sugar
2 cups water
Rind and juice of an orange, cook and purée. You may whip before freezing. (Very good)

FROZEN PLUM PUDDING
In top of double boiler melt 1/2 squares of chocolate 1/2 cup sugar. Add 1/2 cup 1/2 evaporated milk and stir until blended. Add 1 cup water 1/2 cinnamon 1/2 cup cherries pineapple (canned) 1/2 cup raisins 1/2 cup nut meats. Beat with egg beater once during the freezing. You may if liked when serving add one tablespoon of sweet wine or brandy to each serving.

ENGLISH PLUM PUDDING
1 cup raisins
1 cup currants
1 cup flour
1 cup bread crumbs
1 cup suet
1 cup brown sugar
2 or 3 dried orange, lemon peel
1 oz. citron
2 eggs (beat whites separately)
1/2 cinnamon, cloves, ginger, allspice and nut.
Mix all ingredients, adding sufficient milk in mixing so that spoon will stand upright in dough when mixed. Steam 3 1/2 hours. Serve with lemon, wine or brandy sauce.

MINCIE MEAT (from an old file)
3 lbs. beef—use suet if you like (two did not)
1/2 lb. apples
2 qt. cider
1 pt. molasses
2 lbs. sugar (brown)
2 lbs. raisins, cup currants
1/2 lb. citron
Allspice, cinnamon, cloves to taste
Lett's blue pepper salt
Brandy makes a nice addition.

Laundry-Chute Finds Favor

The household laundry chute is becoming more and more popular. Older homes, constructed before the convenience came into general use, need not be deprived of this labor saver. Laundry chutes are one of the many kinds of improvements which may be installed and financed under the Mortgage Credit Plan of the Federal Housing Administration.

The household laundry chute may be built for rectangular or round shape. Should be about 2 1/2 feet high, 18 inches in width and may be made of wood or steel. Metal if wood is used the surface should be sanded smooth to prevent snagging the clothes.

The chute can be built to the laundry floor with an access door at the top. The chute can be placed directly under the pipe. The outlet opening should be kept about 4 feet from the floor.

There is a wide field of choice for the prospective homeowner in selecting exterior wall material, but there are many factors which should help to influence that choice. Suitability of material to climate, economy of upkeep and relative permanence in the locality should be an effect upon choice. Consulting a discussion of materials, various characteristics of stone, concrete, adobe and steel are described here briefly by Federal Housing Administration officials. Materials previously described included cardboard, shingles, brick and stucco.

There are several distinct types of stone walls. Couraged ashlar is the term used to describe the stone when it is laid in horizontal lines so that the bricks or stones are usually uniform in height and size of stone. This type lends toward formality and is common to stately dignified houses.

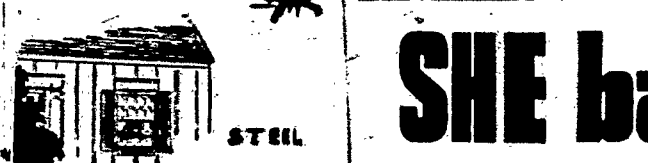
Random ashlar is more informal and describes a wall where the stones are coursed irregularly although still horizontally. This type is found in houses of various architectural periods and was common in the early American farm house where stone was used.

Houses selected from picture area in a good plan book or drawings shown you by a reputable architect can be built to look exactly like their pictures.

Avoid Accidents

One building authority has suggested that an occupying homeowner of the household should be made familiar with the shut-off valves so that in case of a leak or other accident, damage by escaping water can be reduced.

Care should be exercised in laying up stones to avoid patchy appearance where the stones vary in color. Often stones are white-washed. Most builders advise against a strong contrast in the color of the mortar joints. Gray, similar to the color of the stone is regarded as the best shade for mortar.

Concrete houses are usually formed of concrete block units laid similar to ashlar stone. Like stone the mortar joints should be kept neutral in color for best appearance. Concrete is also frequently white-washed.

Not all concrete houses are made of blocks, and where the walls are poured, patented forms to make possible air spaces in the concrete may be used.

Adobe is a term used to describe sun-baked clay units which usually are much larger than the average brick size. A hard-made product confined exclusively to southwestern United States, adobe is accepted by the Federal Housing Administration only in California, New Mexico and Arizona. Houses with walls of steel have been used to a limited extent in recent years. When properly designed, they provide economical construction with the advantage of being fire-resistant.

bracelet pins or compact. These are often marked with the brides' initials, initials or engraved with the wedding date. The luncheon is a simple party meal and the decorations are usually in white and green with wedding place cards.

Professional Services
The caterer, the florist and any other agencies which are to supply professional services should not be consulted. A large wedding should never be attempted without this assistance. Florists will decorate church and home, supply all wedding party flowers, and sometimes have arranging benches and white aisle cloth available. Estimates on these services must be secured early.

Transportation to and from the church for the wedding party is another fruit cake, made well in advance of the wedding. This is cut up and packed in small white boxes or tin and its weight is taken by ribbon from the guests to take to the scene. The bride's cake is white and is usually decorated with small fortune-telling wedding charms, available at ten-cent stores and jewelers, may be based in this cake. 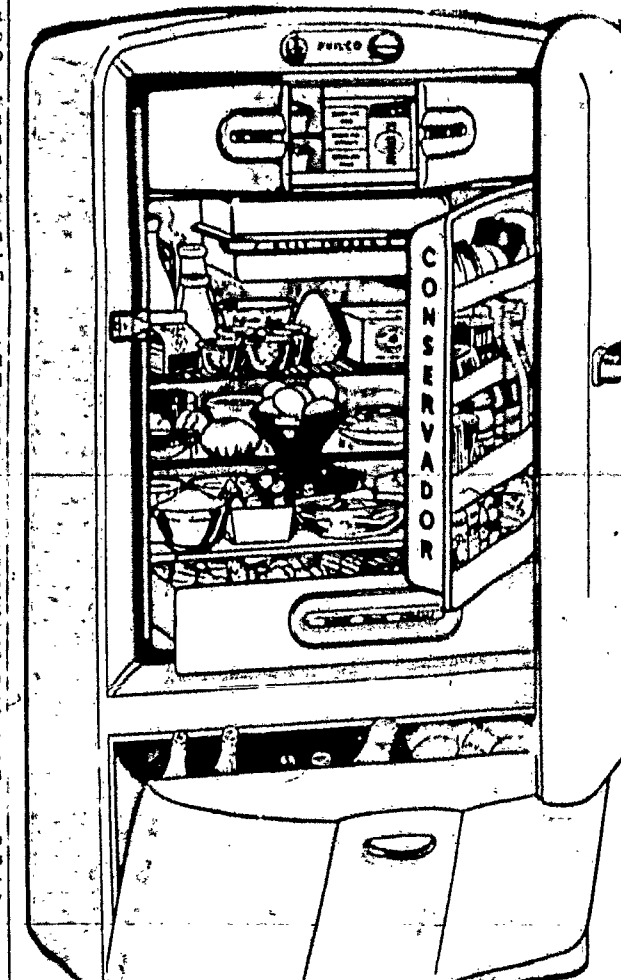
