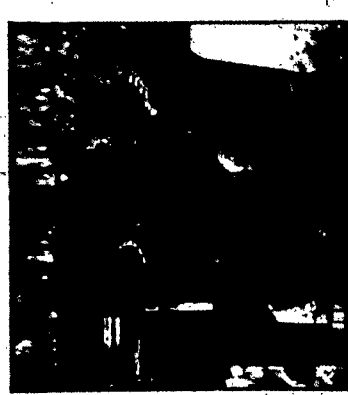

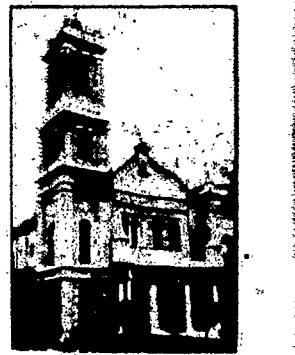

2 MEXICAN PUBLICATIONS ARE BANNED FROM MAILED

MEXICO CITY—Circulation in the mails has been forbidden to two Mexican publications, Accion Nacional and El Sinarquista, by the General Direction of Posts and Telegraphs of the Ministry of Communications and Public Works. The two publications are the National Action movement and the National Sinarquista Union, the two forces that probably deserve the most credit for saving Mexico from a realization of the civil responsibilities as well as rights, and for the phenomenal vote for Mexican in the recent presidential and congressional elections.

Immaculate Conception BISHOP OPENS TRIDUUM

A Solemn Novena in honor of the Feast of the Immaculate Conception started on Sunday of this week Rev. Joseph Illig who introduced the Novena into the parish last year, is again conducting the services on Friday evening. Bishop Illig will open a Triduum in preparation for the Feast. He will be escorted to the church by delegations from each of the parish organizations. New members will be formally received into the Society of Our Lady and invested in the medal by the bishop at the close of the Novena services.

On Another Errand of Mercy

For the past months we have been listening to plans and deliberations concerning the sending of mercy ships for the transportation of refugees from war-torn Europe. Now we have the story of another type of mercy ship, one which may be so-called even without the knowledge of its owners. When the St. City of Benares left New York Harbor recently three of the passengers were members of the Society of Catholic Medical Missionaries. Dr. Elmer Wilson, Dr. Louis Tumm, and Sister M. Peter, all bound for India, to work in medical centers there.
